

Acceptable Use Policy

This document defines acceptable and unacceptable conduct related to your use of the Services. Please read it carefully. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Policy may result in the suspension or termination of your access to the Services.

This Policy forms part of the Contract between you (irrespective of whether you are a Customer or End User) and us. Capitalised terms used and undefined have the meaning outlined in the General Terms of Service or End User Terms. Remember that if you are an End User, our Customer may have its own policies and rules regarding the use of the Services.

When using the Services, you must:

- comply with the terms of the Contract, which include this Acceptable Use Policy;
- comply with the applicable legal provisions, especially those regarding intellectual property and the protection of personal data;
- ensure that you have all necessary rights to upload and distribute Customer Data or End User Data, respectively;
- keep your login details (email and password) confidential and make reasonable efforts to prevent anyone else from accessing your account;
- notify us immediately if you have noticed or suspect an unauthorised attempt to access your account, a security breach, a loss or theft of data or if your login details have been disclosed in an unauthorised manner;

When using the Services, you must not:

- allow other persons to use your account;
- probe, scan or test the vulnerability of our systems;
- upload malware or take actions that could disrupt the normal functioning of the Services;
- send advertising or promotional messages or any type of unsolicited, unauthorised or spam communications;
- violate or circumvent any security or authentication measure;
- access, modify or use non-public areas or parts of the Services or common areas of the Services to which you have been invited;
- upload or transfer through the Services, files, software or links that contain or redirect to a virus, trojan, worm or other harmful component or technology that illegally accesses or downloads content or information stored within the Services or on the hardware of our's or any third party's;
- attempt to copy, modify, decompile, disable, translate or disrupt the functions, functionality, integrity or performance of the Services or reverse engineer them;
- try to circumvent storage space limits;

- upload or distribute data that in any way violates the law or the intellectual property rights of others;
- encourage or support other people in behaviours that violate this Policy.
